Flower Veins-Something you can play around with this summer is capturing the “veins” of flowers. Yes they have them. Some flowers more pronounced than others. The stems, leaves and petals are supplied with water & nutrients through them. And don’t forget to try and get what’s in the throat of the flower, the Pistil parts. Sometimes leaving this out is like leaving out the eye(s) when you photograph birds or animals. Don’t do that.



Bird Feather Barbules- All those teeny-tiny “sticky outy” things that make up the feather. To bring your bird photography up a couple of levels you want to try and capture those. The same goes for trying to capture the individual hairs of animals. Look at www.thomasmangelsensphotography.com or www.andyrouse.co.uk take some time to study their work.
