

By-Laws

Central Iowa Camera Club

Marshalltown, Iowa

Article I

The name of this group shall be the Central Iowa Camera Club. Its purposes are social intercourse in a friendly environment, and the encouragement and improvement of the photographic attitudes and skills of its members.

Article II

Membership shall be open to any person of good character who is interested in the purpose of this group, and whose application has been approved by any officer. A member is in good standing after payment of annual dues, set here at \$7.00 for a year. The Fiscal Year begins September 1st. and annual dues are payable September 1.

Regular meetings shall be held the first Thursday of each month September through May, subject to exceptions or additions as authorized by action of the Board of Directors.

Article III

The officers shall be a President, Vice-President, and a Secretary-Treasurer. They shall be elected for a period of one year. The election shall be held at the May meeting from a slate entered by a nominating committee appointed by the President prior to the meeting. The election, to be conducted by the outgoing President, shall be open to nominations from the floor. New officers shall take office September first.

The President shall preside at all meetings; shall have general supervision of all the Club and its officers; shall appoint chairpersons of committees, and be an ex-officio member of all committees.

The Vice-President shall serve in the absence of the President. The Secretary-Treasurer shall keep all records and books of account, and shall collect dues and pay such bills as have been approved by the Board of Directors.

Article IV

The affairs of the club will be managed by the Board of Directors, which shall be composed of the officers of the club, Committee Chairpersons, and the immediate past President. A quorum shall consist of four members.

Meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held on call of the President. In the President's incapacity his duties shall fall on the Vice-President. The Board of Directors are empowered to fill vacancies which occur in its membership.

Article V

Amendments to these By-Laws may be made at any meeting of the Board of Directors, subject to approval of the membership at the next regular meeting.

Article VI

The Board of Directors may adopt such rules and regulations with respect to management, discipline and procedure as are consistent with the Articles in these By-Laws.

* A Junior membership is available to full-time students who have not graduated from high school. Dues shall be \$2.00 per year.

The following amendments were adopted by the CICC membership on June 3, 1993:

Amendment I - Article II

Membership shall be open to any person of good character who is interested in the purposes of this group. A member is in good standing after payment of annual dues, set here at \$10.00 for a single, \$15.00 for a couple/family, and \$5.00 for a student (high school/college). The Fiscal Year begins September 1st. and annual dues are payable September 1.

Regular meetings shall be held the first Thursday of each month September through June, subject to exceptions or additions as authorized by action of the Board of Directors.

Amendment II - Article IV

The affairs of the Club will be managed by the Board of Directors which shall be composed of the officers of the Club, Committee Chairpersons, and immediate past President. A quorum shall consist of four members.

Meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held the second Thursday of each month September through June. The Board of Directors are empowered to fill vacancies which occur in its membership.

June 3, 1993

The following amendment was adopted by the CICC membership on October 5, 2000:

Amendment III - Article III

The officers shall be President, Vice-President, Secretary, and a Treasurer. They shall be elected for a period of one year. The election shall be held at the May meeting from a slate entered by a nominating committee appointed by the President prior to the meeting. The election, to be conducted by the outgoing President, shall be open to nominations from the floor. New officers shall take office September first.

The President shall preside at all meetings; shall have general supervision of all the Club and its officers; shall appoint chairpersons of

committees, and be an ex-officio member of all committees.

The Vice-President shall serve in the absence of the President. The Secretary shall keep all records. The Treasurer shall keep all books of account, and shall collect dues and pay such bills as have been approved by the Board of Directors.
